## <u>Fire Drill</u>

Next Thursday (17<sup>th</sup> October) JPS will be conducting our 3<sup>rd</sup> emergency drill for the year. Since we are entering into our bushfire season, the school will be conducting a *fire drill*, and we will be reminding our students of the processes involved.



## Arrangements in the event of a bushfire would include:

- 1. Smaller non-threatening fires would involve us sheltering in place at the school. Parents would be notified using phone or mobile phones if those are still operating.
- 2. If the school building is under threat, students will be vacated to the Courthouse Hotel and parents will be notified using phone or mobile phones if those are still operating.
- 3. The school community is advised that the school must close on a forecasted day of Catastrophic FDR in our fire weather district. <u>Closure means that no one can attend the school site, and that learning from home cannot be conducted.</u>
- 4. Where and when possible, home learning packs will be provided to students.
- 5. Please refer to the detailed communication regarding our arrangements that was sent out at the start of Term 4.
